What is TIMEQCC?

- TIMEQCC provides the first two years of preparation for prospective secondary school mathematics teachers.
- Upon completion of an Associates Degree at Queensborough CC, students will transfer to a senior CUNY college or a private college to complete the baccalaureate.
- Scholarship opportunities for junior and senior years are currently available at Queens College and NYU.

Requirements for acceptance into TIMEQCC

- Completion of 12 credits of college courses with an overall GPA of 2.75
- Completion of precalculus (MA-440 or equivalent) with a grade of B or better
- A letter of recommendation from a mathematics professor

Special Features of TIMEQCC

- Paid tutoring internships in the Mathematics Learning Center and/or local high schools
- Free tutoring in all mathematics courses
- Faculty mentoring
- Opportunities for mathematics research
